

Scottsmoor Community Association
Amended Minutes for February 22, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President, Marieanne Syverson. Other officers present were Arnie Benson, and Glenda VanGilder, treasurer. 26 members were present. Secretary Kate Perez was excused.

Introduction of Guests – Central Florida Animal Reserve directors, Dr. Thomas Blue, Dr. Kevin Wiltz, and Ms. Sharon Farrar presented a video to, and answered questions from, the audience about the their tiger rescue operation. They hope to use the new facility to educate school children and the public. Ultimately, the plan is to open the facility to the public on about 18 acres in Scottsmoor. Breeding is not the mission, with the possible exception of some, very endangered species like the white tiger. Most animals are being neutered. The organization is non-profit and is mostly staffed by well-trained volunteers. The animals are supervised 24 hours per day and 7 days per week. The perimeter fence is 8 ft., and there are many additional regulatory required safeguards in place. They currently have 51 cats. For more information, please see their website at www.cflar.org

Other – There were two Deaths in Scottsmoor since the last meeting. The Scottsmoor Community Association sent cards to the families of John Weaver and Shirley Montgomery.

Next meeting of the Scottsmoor community Association will be Monday the 22th of March. This will be the meeting at which members will elect the Treasurer and Vice President of the Association. Membership dues must be paid in full by March 1 in order to be able to vote in the upcoming election.
