

Scottsmoor Community Association Meeting

Minutes for July 25th, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 pm by President, Arnold Benson. A pot luck dinner was held prior to the meeting. 18 persons were in attendance for the meal and 19 people attended the meeting.
