Minutes for August 22, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President, Arnold Benson. A pot luck dinner was held prior to the meeting. It was attended by 24 people, and 26 people attended the meeting. John Scott indicated that CF News 13, www.embrevard.com, and 211 do an excellent job of reporting local events. He also stressed the importance of having an emergency plan and a disaster supply kit. Committee reports

Public Relations – Doug Chamberlain reported the sympathy and get well cards that were sent.

Membership Committee – Bryan Kyle reported we have 113 paid members.

New Business – We are looking into retaining an accountant to file the necessary paperwork to attain 501c3 status. Doug Chamberlain moved that we have a yard sale on Saturday, October 29. Kathy Goff seconded the motion, and it carried. Arnold Benson stated that we'll need people to work the fundraiser, and income from a bake sale may be used to fund kid's games at the next Fourth of July picnic.

50/50 – The raffle was won by Elizabeth Taylor. The split was \$22.50 to Elizabeth and \$22.50 to the house.
