The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President, Arnold Benson. A pot luck dinner was held prior to the meeting. 37 persons were in attendance for the meal and 38 people attended the meeting. Doug Chamberlain led the Pledge of Allegiance and Ed Rost gave the Invocation. Other officers present were Robert Robbins, Vice President, Bryan Kyle, treasurer, Lee Bird, secretary, and Doug Chamberlain, Executive Committee Member. Executive Committee Member Marieanne Syverson was absent.

Introduction of Guests included Steve Douglas from Scottsmoor, Ron Barcher from the Mims Community Group, and Phyllis Willingham from Parrish Medical Center, our guest speaker for the night.

The minutes from the previous meeting were handed out and read by Lee Bird, Secretary. Doug Chamberlain moved that the minutes be approved as read, and Dietmar Unger seconded the motion. No discussion ensued, and the minutes were approved by a vote of the membership.

Treasurer's Report – Bryan Kyle reported that our current balance is \$10,014.59. Brian asked for a motion to reimburse Vinnie Palmieri \$82.16 for expenses incurred in preparation for tonight's meal. Doug Chamberlain made the motion and Dietmar Unger seconded. The motion was approved by membership vote.

Guest Speaker - Phyllis Willingham, RN, MS, Healthcare Liaison for Parrish Medical Center gave a brief presentation reviewing the benefits that Parrish Medical Center offers the community. She discussed the 9 recent awards PMC had earned in the health community and how Home Health can benefit everyone. The presentation was well received.

Committee Reports:

Meeting Hall – Lee Bird reported that total attendance in the Meeting Hall for April was 183. The Meeting Hall Calendar for June & July was passed out and reviewed.

Lee Bird gave an update on SB550 (septic tank bill). It was noted that the Florida Senate failed to act on the repeal of the bill and will take it up in next year's agenda.
