

Scottsmoor Community Association Meeting

Minutes for November 28, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President, Arnold Benson. A potluck dinner was held prior to the meeting. Robert Robbins led the Pledge of Allegiance and Arnie Benson gave the invocation. Other officers present included Robert Robbins, Vice President, Bryan Kyle, Treasurer, Lee Bird, Secretary and Doug Chamberlain, Executive Committee Member. Executive Committee Member Marianne Syverson was absent.

Minutes - The minutes from the previous meeting were read by Lee Bird, Secretary. Kathy Goff moved that the minutes be approved as read, and Ed Rost seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Treasurer's Report – Bryan Kyle reported that our current balance is \$10,218.87. Kate Perez moved that the Treasurer's Report be accepted as read and Anita Goforth seconded. The motion was approved.

Committee reports

Meeting Hall – Lee Bird reported that total attendance in the Meeting Hall for October was 304. He passed out the calendar for December & January, and noted that Corrine Stokes was signed up to clean the hall for December.

Public Relations – Doug Chamberlain sent a get-well card to Barbara Bird, and a condolences card to the Carver Family.

Membership Committee – Bryan Kyle reported we have 114 paid members.

Float Committee – Bryan Kyle announced that the float would be decorated at 6pm on Tuesday, 11/29 and asked everyone to stop by and help.

Finance Report – Bryan Kyle passed out the 2012 financial budget and discussed the changes. Grady Wright moved that the budget be approved and Joe Goforth seconded. The motion passed.

Special Events – Arnie announced that the float would be used in 3 parades: The Mims Parade on Dec. 3rd, the Titusville Parade on Dec. 10th, and the Scottsmoor Parade on Dec. 18th. The Christmas Party on Dec. 19th was discussed. Lee Bird offered to cover all costs of the food and have his Aunt Patsy cater the event if the date was changed to Dec. 14th. Kate Perez moved that we accept Lee's offer, and Bobbi Partain seconded. The motion passed. Arnie announced the House Decorating Contest would be judged on Dec. 21st, and winners would be announced on Dec. 23rd. Arnie also announced that the quarterly Attendance drawing would be held at the Christmas Party on Dec. 14th. Kate Perez announced that Unity Church would provide stuffed animals to be distributed on the Christmas float for the Scottsmoor Christmas Parade.

Old business – The outdoor sign continues to be vandalized. Arnie asked everyone to keep an eye out and report any suspicious activity around the Meeting Hall. Arnie gave a recap of the Yard Sale, and announced \$151.60 was raised for kids games for the 4th of July Picnic. Arnie announced Bobbi Partain as the new Community Information Cabinet caretaker and thanked Elizabeth Taylor for doing such a good job.

New Business – Arnie reminded everyone that we would be holding elections for VP & Treasurer in 2012. Bryan Kyle will not run for re-election, and Robert Robbins agreed to run again for VP. The Guest Speakers list was discussed, and Bryan Kyle moved that we not allow political candidates as guest speakers. Joe Goforth seconded, and the motion passed. Kathy Goff made a motion that there be no gift exchange at the Christmas Party this year, and Bryan Kyle seconded. The motion passed. Robert Robbins made a motion that anyone wanting to donate an unwrapped toy to the Toys for Tots program bring it to the Party and place it under the Christmas tree. Anita Goforth seconded, and the motion passed. Kate Perez made a motion to e-mail the advertisers about our website advertising, and Anita Goforth seconded. The motion passed, and Kate will email.

50/50 – The raffle was won by Grady Wright (surprise) and the split was \$15 to Grady & \$15 to the house.

Adjournment – The motion to adjourn was made by Bryan Kyle at 8:24 PM.
