

# Scottsmoor Community Association Meeting

## Minutes for October 24, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President, Arnold Benson. A pot luck dinner was held prior to the meeting. It was attended by 27 people, and 32 people attended the meeting. Robert Robbins led the Pledge of Allegiance and Pastor Marty Galyon gave the invocation. Other officers present included Robert Robbins, Vice President, Bryan Kyle, Treasurer, Lee Bird, Secretary and Doug Chamberlain, Executive Committee Member. Executive Comm. Member Marieanne Syverson was absent.

**Introduction of Guests** included Commissioner Robin Fisher and Pastor Marty Galyon.

**Minutes** - from the previous meeting were read by Lee Bird, Secretary. Doug Chamberlain moved that the minutes be approved as read, and Kate Perez seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

**Treasurer's Report** – Bryan Kyle reported that our current balance is \$10,214.49

**Guest Speakers** – Ron Barcher from the Mims Community Group updated the group on commercial construction in Mims, and said the Tractor Supply project was a done deal. Construction on the Tractor Supply building could begin as soon as April, 2012.

Commissioner Robin Fisher talked about the Greater Titusville Renaissance program to improve the northern entrances to the county. He indicated that there were plans to convert the Miracle City Mall to a medical facility and retail shops. He also said Linda Weatherman of the Economic Development Council would soon announce 500 new jobs at the Space Center, and discussed the North Brevard Economic Development Zone. The presentation was well received.

### Committee reports

**Meeting Hall** – Lee Bird reported that total attendance in the Meeting Hall for September was 176. He passed out the calendar for November & December, and noted that Arnie Benson was responsible for cleaning the building so well in October. Doug & Arlene Chamberlain are signed up to clean for November.

**Public Relations** – Doug Chamberlain had nothing to report.

**Membership Committee** – Bryan Kyle reported we have 115 paid members.

**Special Events** – Robert Robbins reported that he didn't know how many booths were rented for the yard sale. Bryan Kyle made a motion to cancel the yard sale and Robert Robbins seconded the motion. After a brief discussion, a vote was held and the motion was defeated. Arnie Benson indicated that 9 booths were already rented, and Anne Foster would run the bake sale table to benefit the 4<sup>th</sup> of July kid's games. Lee Bird announced that he was working on biscuits and gravy for the yard sale.

**Old business** – The outdoor sign has been repaired and repainted and is being used outside the Meeting Hall once again, thanks to Doug Chamberlain and Arnie Benson.

**New Business** – Jessie McCoskey announced that the First Baptist Church of Scottsmoor would be distributing food baskets again this Thanksgiving, and thanked the Association for the canned goods donated by the Walk Away the Pounds group. Doug Chamberlain made a motion to donate \$200.00 to the church for the food basket program, and Ed Rost seconded the motion. The motion passed. Kate Perez made a motion to provide a link to [greatertitusville.com](http://greatertitusville.com) on our website, and Anita Goforth seconded the motion. The motion passed. Arnie Benson announced the Association will provide baked chicken for the next pot luck prior to November's meeting so that everyone could bring a dish to compliment the main meat.

**50/50** – The raffle was won by Glenda Ceballos (AGAIN!). The split was \$20.50 to Glenda and \$20.50 to the house.

**Adjournment** – The motion to adjourn was made by Lee Bird at 8:14 PM.
