

Scottsmoor Community Association Meeting

Minutes for September 26th, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President, Arnold Benson. A pot luck dinner was held prior to the meeting. It was attended by 26 people, and 30 people attended the meeting. Robert Robbins led the Pledge of Allegiance and Arnie Benson gave the invocation. Treasurer's Report – Bryan Kyle reported that our current balance is \$10,337.91

Guest Speakers – Erin LeClair, Recycling Educator from Brevard County Waste Management gave a presentation about our county landfill and the recycling that goes on in the county. The presentation was well received by the membership.

Committee reports

Meeting Hall – Lee Bird reported that total attendance in the Meeting Hall for August was 179. He passed out the calendar for October & November, and noted that Anne Foster was responsible for cleaning the building so well in September. Sheryl Scherr is signed up to clean the Meeting Hall for October. Lee also demonstrated the new PA system he got for the Hall from Craigs List and asked if anyone had extra microphones we could use.

Public Relations – Doug Chamberlain reported that we would have a walker and port-a-pot available for area residents to borrow when needed and encouraged others to donate item of a like nature.

Membership Committee – Bryan Kyle reported we have 113 paid members.

Special Events – Robert Robbins reported that the yard sale booths would be \$30, \$20, and \$10, and the yard sale would run from 8am to 4pm. Contact Robert if you want to rent a booth.

Old business – The outdoor sign has been placed in the metal building until improvements can be made to it. No new updates on 501C3 status. Ron Bartcher gave a brief update on the new business construction in Mims. Glenda Van Guilder moved that we repay Lee Bird for the PA system, and Cookie Rost seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

New Business – Arnie Benson announced that the county would be holding a public meeting on the new tax rates on 9/26 in Viera.
