

## Scottsmoor Community Association

### Minutes for April 28, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Arnold Benson. A pot luck dinner featuring ham was held before the meeting. There were 31 people at the dinner and 33 at the meeting. Vice President Joe Goforth led the Pledge of Allegiance and President Benson asked for a moment of silence. Officers present were President Arnold Benson, Vice President Joe Goforth, Treasurer Bryan Kyle, Secretary Trent Minch and Executive Committee Member Doug Chamberlain.

**Minutes**-The minutes from the previous meeting were distributed. Doug Chamberlain moved that the minutes be approved and Robert Robbins seconded. The motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report** –Treasurer Kyle reported that our current balance is \$10,176.51. Doug Chamberlain moved that the report be accepted and Robert Robbins seconded. The motion carried.

#### **Committee Reports**

**Meeting Hall**-President Benson reported that attendance at the meeting hall in March was 190 and briefly discussed the May and June calendars.

**Public Relations**-Doug Chamberlain reported that cards were sent to the family of George Sanders and Arnie Benson.

**Mims Report** – Ron Barcher reported that the construction of phase 1 of the cemetery is to start sometime this year.

**Membership Committee**-Bryan Kyle reported that we have 78 members.

**Special events**- President Benson reported that Parrish Park is reserved for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July picnic at no cost. President Benson also is looking to appoint a committee of four to solicit prizes from businesses for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July picnic. So far Anita Goforth, Rose McGinnis and Elizabeth Taylor have volunteered their services for the committee. Bryan Kyle reported that the association made \$374.25 from concessions at the spring yard sale. He also reported that the association now has \$659 designated for the bounce house and water slide for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July picnic. Secretary Trent Minch, reported that Pinewood Elementary sent a thank you letter to the Association for its school supplies donations.

**Old Business**-President Benson reported that the referendum funds may be distributed elsewhere. Commissioner Robin Fisher wants the monies to go to areas where it will serve more people.

**New Business**-Treasurer Kyle would like to look for bids for ongoing floor maintenance.

**Other Considerations**- President Benson reported that he needs a volunteer to attend and present at the North Brevard Parks and Recreation Committee meeting. Joe Goforth volunteered. Bobby Partain is finishing the Scottsmoor yearbook and is looking to add more photos of the current year (July 4<sup>th</sup> 2013 – Present). Anita Goforth and Rose McGinnis volunteered to provide pork roast for next month's pot luck dinner. President Benson announced that he would like to donate approximately \$400.00 in prizes to be raffled off in addition to the cash prizes at the 4<sup>th</sup> of July picnic again this year and will reward the member who sells the most raffle ticket with dinner for two at the restaurant of their choice.

**50/50 Raffle**-The raffle was won by Rose McGinnis. The split was \$29 to Rose and \$29 to the Association.

**Adjournment**-The motion to adjourn was made by Anita Goforth at 8:06 PM.
